PARTIES

1. This is a Consent Agreement regarding the license of Corey Vintinner to work as an electrician within the State of Maine. The parties to this Consent Agreement are Corey Vintinner ("the licensee"); the Electricians' Examining Board ("the Board"); and the Maine Department of Attorney General ("the Attorney General"). This Consent Agreement is entered into pursuant to 10 MRSA §8003(5)(B).

FACTS

- 2. On January 22, 2008, Corey Vintinner applied for a license to the Board.
- 3. Corey Vintinner willfully failed to disclose on the application that he was convicted of the following crime(s):
 Class E, Theft by Receiving Stolen Property on 9/18/96

VIOLATION

- 4. Title 10 M.R.S.A. §8003(5-A)(A)(1) provides in relevant part that "the board may deny or refuse to renew a license ...for ... the practice of fraud, deceit or misrepresentation in obtaining a license from the board ... or in connection with services rendered while engaged in the occupation or profession for which the person is licensed." For the reasons set forth, the board believes that you failed to disclose a criminal conviction(s) on a license application, and that this nondisclosure constitutes the practice of fraud or deceit in obtaining a license in violation of 10 M.R.S.A. §8003(5-A)(A)(1).
- 5. The licensee admits that his non-disclosure of the above-mentioned conviction on the application dated January 22, 2008 constituted the practice of fraud or deceit in obtaining a license in violation of 10 MRSA §8003(5-A)(A)(1).

PENALTY

6. As discipline for this violation, the licensee shall pay a civil penalty of \$25.00 no later than March 5, 2008.

MISCELLANEOUS


8. This Consent Agreement is not appealable and remains in effect until modified or rescinded in writing by the parties.

The licensee acknowledges by his signature below that he has read this Consent Agreement, that he has had an opportunity to consult with an attorney before executing this Consent Agreement, that he executed this Consent of his own free will, and that he agrees to abide by the terms of this Consent Agreement.


