



## COVENANTS

In order to resolve fully this matter without further legal proceedings, it is agreed to among the parties that:

1. Ms. Dietz admits that she did not answer application question regarding criminal history truthfully and agrees to accept a FORMAL REPRIMAND from the Board as sanction for said violation;

2. Ms. Dietz also agrees to pay a fine of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) as sanction for said violation. Said fine must be paid by **CERTIFIED CHECK OR MONEY ORDER** made payable to "Treasurer, State of Maine" and submitted at the time Ms. Dietz submits the signed Consent Agreement;

3. Ms. Dietz agrees to abide by all of the laws and rules of the State of Maine governing the provision of cosmetological services in the future;

4. The Board agrees that upon receipt of the signed Consent Agreement and the fine payment, it will issue an aesthetician license to Ms. Dietz contingent upon her meeting all other eligibility criteria;

5. The Attorney General and the Board agree that no further agency or legal action will be taken against Ms. Dietz's license based on the facts described herein, except in the event that Ms. Dietz does not comply fully with the terms of the Consent Agreement;

6. The Consent Agreement is not subject to appeal;

7. The Consent Agreement is not subject to amendment except by written agreement of all parties;

8. The Consent Agreement is a public document within the meaning of 1 M.R.S.A.

§ 402, et seq.;


9. Ms. Dietz understands that the execution of the Consent Agreement is completely voluntary and that she has the right to consult with an attorney before signing the Consent Agreement; and

10. Ms. Dietz understands that her signature indicates that she has read and understands the Consent Agreement and that Ms. Dietz enters into it of her own free will.


