

COVENANTS

7. Ms. Henderson admits that she failed to complete and provide proof of satisfactory completion of continuing professional education as required by 32 M.R.S. §9909(2) and Board Rules Chapter 2, Section 3(B)(1)(b), and admits that such failure constitutes grounds for discipline pursuant to 32 M.R.S. § 9910(2)(D) and 10 M.R.S. § 8003(5)(A-1).
8. As discipline for the conduct admitted in paragraph 8 above, the Licensee accepts the following disciplinary action:
 - a. a WARNING from the Board; and
 - b. within one hundred eighty (180) days of signing this agreement, Ms. Henderson will obtain, and provide the Board with documentary proof of the completion of, four (4) hours of category I continuing professional education. The four (4) hours shall not be used for any other licensing purpose, including meeting the continuing education requirements accruing during the next licensing period.
9. This Consent Agreement is not appealable and is effective until modified or rescinded by the parties hereto.
10. The Board and Ms. Henderson agree that violation of any of the terms or conditions of this Consent Agreement shall constitute grounds for discipline, including modification, suspension, or revocation of licensure and denial of licensure or re-licensure.
11. Nothing herein shall prohibit the Board from making an order to revoke, suspend, or modify Ms. Henderson's license or from assessing any other penalty, in the event that Ms. Henderson does not comply with the terms of this Consent Agreement or in the event that the Board otherwise deems it advisable in the performance of its duties.
12. This Consent Agreement is a public record within the meaning of 1 M.R.S. § 402 and will be made available for inspection and copying by the public pursuant to 1 M.R.S. § 408.
13. Nothing in this Consent Agreement shall be construed to affect any right or interest of any person not a party hereto.
14. Ms. Henderson understands that execution of this agreement is completely voluntary and that she has the right to consult with an attorney before signing the consent agreement.

15. Ms. Henderson acknowledges by her signature hereto that she has read this Consent Agreement, that she executed this Consent Agreement of her own free will and that she agrees to abide by all terms and conditions set forth herein.
