## Eligibility criteria and other information for Active Enlisted Military Personnel Day-Use Park Pass

- 1. Military member's home of residence is Maine.
- 2. Military member is serving in an enlisted grade in the armed forces as defined in 10 United States Code, Section 101(a)(4).

Passes issued are valid for 12 months and may be renewed upon verification of continuing eligibility.

Pass entitles holder, and the holder's spouse and children when accompanied by the holder, to admission free of charge to all state parks and historic sites.

Passes are non-transferrable and may not be used by anyone other than the holder. Failure to abide by this will result in a loss of privileges.
