On January 1, 2018 Maine hospitals began implementing a pilot program to identify veterans in need of mental and behavioral health care.

The Department of Health and Human Services, in coordination with the Maine Bureau of Veterans' Services, has entered into contracts with both EasterSeals Maine and Health Affiliates Maine in an effort to ensure a statewide network of case management is established, which will provide coordinated mental health care services to Maine veterans.

Both EasterSeals Maine and Health Affiliates Maine were selected to serve as participating providers due to their recent history of working with service members, veterans and their families.

Qualifying veterans include:

- ◆ A veteran who has received a mental health diagnosis or mental health disability rating from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs.
- ◆ Any veteran who has served in the United States Armed Forces, including Active Duty as well as National Guard and Reserve members, who need mental health treatment or mental health navigation.
- ◆ Any service member currently serving in the Armed Forces.

Organizations and/or providers are encouraged to make referrals on behalf of veterans in need of care.

Veterans are also encouraged to self refer.
