II. Area(s) where pesticide will be applied:

seasonal wetlands, roadside ditches, small localized
wetlands along forested roadsides (gravel roads).

pdf maps showing spots to be treated will be submitted
to BOARD prior to treatments

III. Pesticide(s) to be applied:

Rodeo (or other approved aquatic glyphosate, AQUANEAT,
AQUAMASTER, AQUAPRO) plus aquatic approved surfactant

IV. Purpose of pesticide application:

to control common reed or Phragmites along
forested roadsides in Northern Maine. FOREST LANDOWNERS
ARE being pressured under ANNUAL SFI or FSC certification
to control INVASIVE plants

V. Approximate dates of spray application:

late August until late September OR FROST
Removes the Phragmites for the current year

VI. Application Equipment:

low volume backpack foliar

VII. Standard(s) to be varied from:

25' buffer on a wetland dominated with emerged aquatic vegetation (in this case phragmites)

VIII. Reason for variance:

the phragmites is the wetland aquatic vegetation we want to remove AND IN SEVERAL CASES IT IS IN WETLAND DEFINED SITES (see Chapter 29 Section 6.A.V.c)

IX. Method to assure equivalent protection:

we will be applying only to phragmites plants using aquatically approved glyphosate and surfactants with category 5A licensed applicator and spray contracting firms
