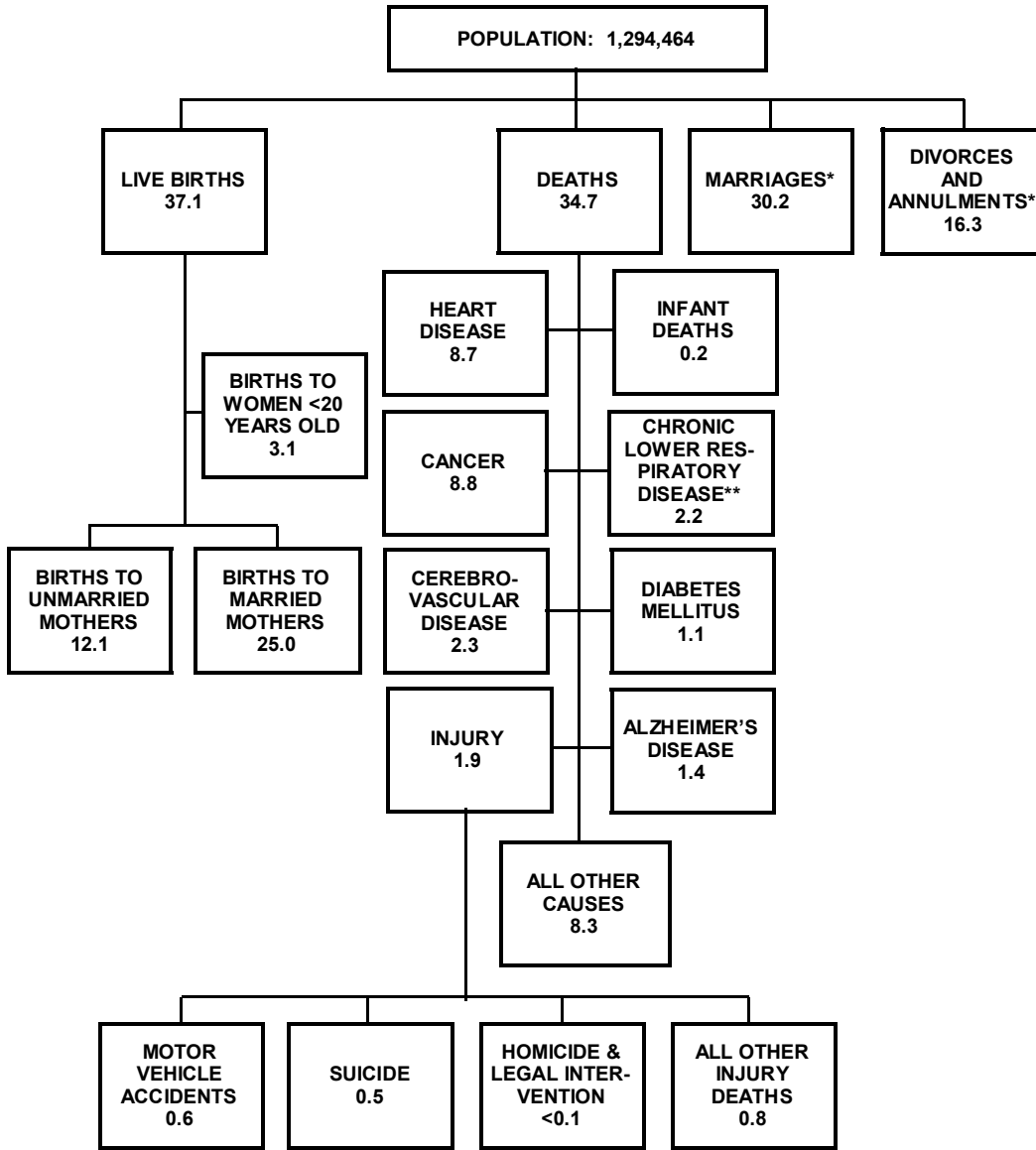


VITAL STATISTICS SUMMARY MAINE 2002

From 1979 to 1998, all causes of death were classified according to the World Health Organization's International Classification of Diseases, 9th Revision (ICD-9). Starting in 1999, the 10th revision was used. For this reason, cause of death data for 1999 and after are not necessarily comparable with previous years.

*These are events occurring in Maine and may include some non-residents.

**Under ICD-10, the Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease category was eliminated and replaced by Chronic Lower Respiratory Disease; the two categories are not comparable.
