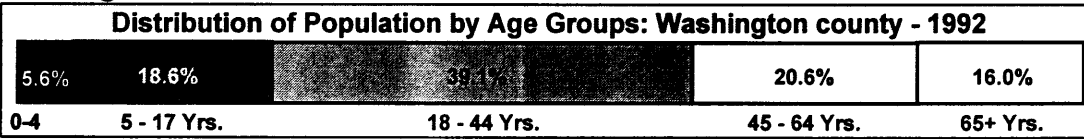


WASHINGTON COUNTY: 1992

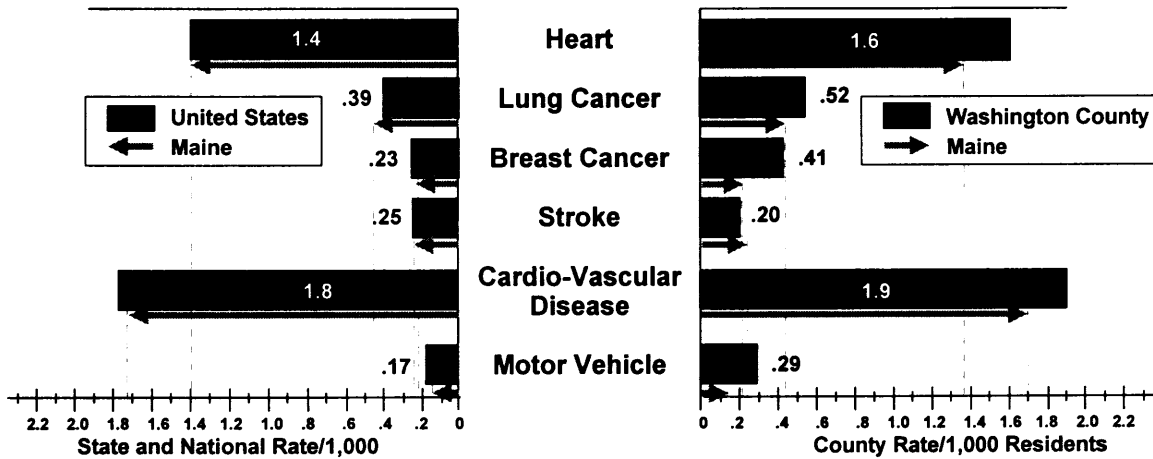
Health Status Indicators

- ➔ **Population:** In 1992, the population of Washington county was 35,897, making it Maine's 11th most populous county.
- ➔ **Population Aged 65 and Older:** In 1992, 5,741 county residents were 65 years old or older, about 16.0% of the county population. This was significantly greater than the national average of 12.7%; the state average was 14%.



- ➔ **Births:** There were 427 births to residents of Washington county; this yielded a county birth rate of 11.9 births for every 1,000 residents, significantly less than the national rate of 14.9/1,000.
- ➔ **Adolescent births (10-17 years old):** 4.4% of all live births in this county were to adolescent mothers; this was significantly greater than the national figure of 3.8%.
- ➔ **Low birth weight babies:** In Washington county, 4.9% of all live births resulted in babies weighing less than 2500 grams (5 1/2 pounds). This was significantly less than the national figure of 5.8%.
- ➔ **Deaths:** There were 422 deaths to county residents in 1992. The age-adjusted death rate*, 4.9, compares to the national rate of 4.9.

- ➔ **Infant Deaths**:** The county infant death rate, 8.6 deaths per 1,000 live births, was significantly greater than the national rate of 7.3 deaths.

* 1991 age-adjusted death rates are for underlying cause of death, U.S. rates are for whites only; rates are age adjusted to the US 1940 standard population; these are rates that have been standardized to eliminate differences due solely to variations in the age composition of the populations.

**Infant deaths were calculated using the average of the infant death rate for the three year period, 1990-1992.
