CERTIFICATE OF MERGER AND NAME CHANGE
Between Biddeford Savings Bank and Mechanics Savings Bank with Biddeford Savings Bank being the resulting institution and changing its name to Maine Community Bank

I, the undersigned Superintendent of the Bureau of Financial Institutions of the State of Maine, have duly received an executed Agreement and Plan of Bank Merger, dated March 1, 2019, by and between Biddeford Savings Bank, whose principal office is located in Biddeford, Maine, and Mechanics Savings Bank, whose principal office is located in Auburn, Maine together with the resolutions of the governing body of the respective institutions approving the Agreement and Plan of Bank Merger, and evidence of shareholder approval, each certified by the president and clerk or secretary of each institution. Biddeford Savings Bank and Mechanics Savings Bank are both investor-owned universal banks organized under the banking laws of the State of Maine. Each bank is wholly-owned by Maine Community Bancorp, Inc., a Maryland corporation, which in turn is wholly-owned by Maine Community Bancorp, MHC, a Maine-chartered mutual holding company. Biddeford Savings Bank and Mechanics Savings Bank have filed a statement that all approvals necessary to undertake the merger have been received and pre-closing conditions have been met.

Upon receipt and review of such statement it appears that all the requirements of law relating to the merger of Mechanics Savings Bank with and into Biddeford Savings Bank have been complied with; therefore, I certify that the merger has been effected in accordance with Chapter 35 of Title 9-B, with the resulting institution named Maine Community Bank.

BE IT FURTHER KNOWN, that the merger and name change are effective January 1, 2020.
