

**PUBLIC NOTICE**  
**Sysladobsis and Horseshoe Lakes Water Access**  
**2,015.5± acres**  
**Lakeville, Penobscot County**

In accordance with 5 M.R.S.A 6200 et seq., the Land for Maine's Future Board will vote on a proposal to allocate funds for the Downeast Lakes Land Trust's purchase of land in the Town of Lakeville, identified as tax parcels 12-01, 12-01-01, 12-01-02, 12-16, and 12-16-09 and described in Book 11054, Page 248, Book 11314, Page 338, Book 13096, and Page 135, Book 13609, Page 163 of the Penobscot County Registry of Deeds. The parcels will be accessible to the public via Depot Road and East Shore Road and provide public access to and from Sysladobsis and Horseshoe Lakes. The Maine Bureau of Parks and Lands will hold a Project Agreement on the land to ensure the property is managed for public recreational access.
