
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This Second Procedural Order (“Order”) of the Land Use Planning Commission (“Commission”) provides a ruling of the Presiding Officer to extend the closure of the hearing record.

1. In the First Procedural Order issued on June 25, 2019, the Presiding Officer established that hearing record would remain open until July 22, 2019, at 5:00 p.m. to allow the public and Parties to file written statements with the Commission, and until July 29, 2019, at 5:00 p.m. to file statements in rebuttal of those filed by the July 22 deadline.
2. On July 10, 2019, the Commission held the hearing in the matter of Rising Tide Towers, LLC’s (“Applicant”) pending application for Development Permit DP 5050 (“Application DP 5050”).
3. Pursuant to the Maine Administrative Procedure Act, 5 M.R.S. § 9062(3) and the Commission’s *Rules for the Conduct of Public Hearings*, 01-672 C.M.R. 5(5.18)(3) (“Chapter 5”), the Presiding Officer revises the close of the hearing record from July 22, 2019, to August 15, 2019, at 5:00 p.m. to allow the submission of additional information.
4. The hearing record will remain open until August 22, 2019, at 5:00 p.m. to file statements in rebuttal of those filed by the August 15 deadline.
5. This Procedural Order is issued by the Presiding Officer pursuant to Chapter 5. All objections to matters contained herein should be timely filed in writing with the Commission staff but are not to be further argued except by leave of the Presiding

Officer. All rulings and objections will be noted in the record. The Presiding Officer may amend this Order at any time.
