## Recap

- March 8, 2023 Commission Meeting Item
  - STR activity in the UT
  - Regulatory approaches of other jurisdictions
  - Recommendation from staff
- Regulatory recommendation for non-commercial STRs =
   Require notice of STR activity in conjunction with STR-specific standards
- Commission recommended obtaining public input on STR activity and the regulatory recommendation
  - Community meetings emphasized

### Recommended Option for Non-Commercial STRs

#### #3 Notice + New STR-Specific Standards

- Retains STRs of one entire dwelling on a lot as a residential use
- Minimal procedural burden: Notice < Registration or Permitting</li>
- Provides useful information
- Protective of resources
- Provides clear basis for enforcement/addressing complaints
- Parallels proposed approach for accessory structures
- May achieve a balance between those who offer homes as short-term rental properties and those who choose not to
- May be a system that is easier to modify moving forward

- Advertise meetings, public comment period, webpage by direct outreach to stakeholders and through existing email lists
- Set up an STR-specific email list with webpage signup
- Keep public up to date by using email lists and the webpage
