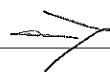


Good Evening

A 1/3 of our tax commitment is paid by ^{that} one taxpayer for the transmission lines to cross in our town from the project on Stetson mountain. If we didn't have them as a taxpayer we wouldn't have been able to improve our roads because our tax mil rate would be between 28 to 30%. Go to your local town office and ask Lincoln, Lee^{or}, Burlington how does our town benefit from these wind projects, you will probably be surprised.
