

Approved Sanitizers For Under 1K Poultry Exempt Operations

- Chlorine-based
 - Sodium hypochlorite (commonly known as bleach)
 - Calcium hypochlorite
 - Chlorine Dioxide
- Quaternary ammonium compounds (quats)
- Iodine-based
- Peroxyacetic acid

The most commonly used sanitizers in poultry production are:

- Chlorine
- Peroxyacetic acid
- Acidified sodium chlorite

Sanitizers allowed if making an “Organic” claim:

- Hydrogen peroxide
- Ozone
- Peracetic acid/ peroxyacetic acid
- Phosphoric acid
- Potassium hydroxide
- Sodium hydroxide
- Chloride Materials
