## 2024 MAINE DUCK STAMP ORDER FORM

Maine's 2024 duck stamp will be available by September 1<sup>st</sup> for purchase by stamp collectors.

In 2003, Maine implemented electronic licenses whereby waterfowl hunting is an authority printed on the electronic license or a check-off box on a manual license. Agents no longer have collector stamps to sell.

Mint condition stamps may be purchased from the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, either in person or by mail (using the order form below). Stamps signed by the artist are also available from the Department. The 2024 stamp was designed by Michael Loring of Windham, Maine, whose painting of a Harlequin, was selected from the contest entries submitted by Maine resident artists.

The Department will sell the 2024 Maine duck stamp until June 30, 2025, after which any unsold stamps will be destroyed. Previous issues (1984-2023) were sold under the same procedure and are available only on the secondary market, from stamp collectors and dealers.

All revenues from the sale of duck stamps are used by the Department for waterfowl habitat acquisition and management.
