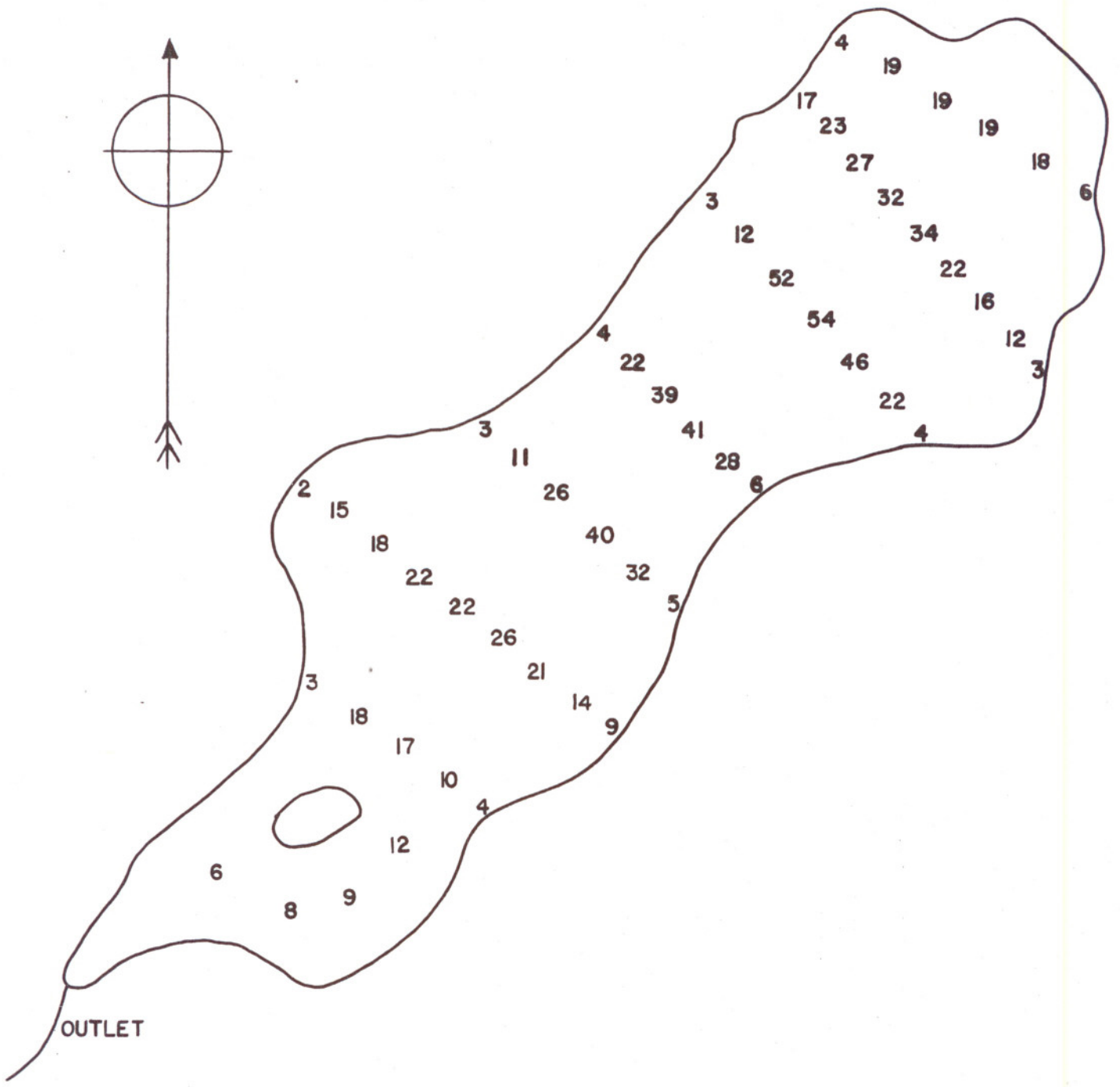

Suggested Management

Wapiti Pond is excellent brook trout habitat and should be managed for this species. Water below the 20-foot level is cold with abundant dissolved oxygen.

Fortunately, the pond contains few competing species, and care should be taken that no further introductions of any other fish species be made. Salmon have been stocked in the past and a few are still caught by fishermen.

Tributary spawning areas are limited and construction of gravel spawning areas in the small spring inlet would increase the success of natural reproduction.
