ORDER GRANTING  
DEFAULT JUDGMENT


The Order and entry is as follows:

1. Defendants Maine Coast Log Homes Inc., Timber Pine Construction, Inc. and Mark A. Holmes were served with the complaint and summons and failed to answer or otherwise appear in this action. Judgment by default is entered against them.
2. Maine Coast Log Homes, Inc. and Timber Pine Construction, Inc. and Mark A. Holmes are permanently enjoined from:
  - a. Advertising, building and selling log home kits;
  - b. Entering into agreements to construct homes; and
  - c. Taking deposits or any payment in advance of delivering products or performing services.
3. Maine Coast Log Homes Inc., Timber Pine Construction, Inc and Mark A. Holmes are jointly and severally liable to pay consumer restitution to the Attorney General to be distributed as follows:

Kristen Richards	\$ 30,000.00
Mary Fisher	\$ 47,200.00
Betty Royce	\$ 44,705.00
John Guyer	\$ 18,242.93
Roger Brocious	<u>\$ 20,149.35</u>
Total Restitution	\$243,349.28

4. Maine Coast Log Homes, Inc., Timber Pine Construction, Inc and Mark A. Holmes are jointly and severally liable to the State of Maine for a civil penalty in the amount of \$35,000. In the event that the restitution described in paragraph 3 above is paid within one year after the entry of this default judgment, then the civil penalty will be suspended.
