Frequently Asked Questions

1. What was the deadline to complete the requirements for the Health Premium Credit Program?

April 30th, 2024 at 11:59pm EST.

2. What were the requirements for the 2024 Health Premium Credit Program?

- 1.) Log on to [WellStarME](#) and
- 2.) Complete the Wellness Questionnaire on [WellStarME](#) and
- 3.) Watch the Primary Care Provider Resources video **and** take a short quiz on [WellStarME](#) (the first question will appear once the video has ended) **and**
- 4.) Complete **one** of the following "My Health" options:
 - Get your numbers from a free-standing lab (Please Note: your primary care provider must send a lab order to your preferred lab.) **OR** get your numbers from your primary care provider
 - OR Receive a Flu Shot
 - OR Have a "Well-Being" visit
 - OR Have an Annual Physical Exam (New this year!)
 - OR Participate in a Health Navigation appointment

"My Health" option may be completed between May 1st, 2023 and April 30th, 2024 at 11:59 PM.

3. What is the premium cost for the health insurance?

4. I have filed an appeal; when will I hear a decision on my appeal?

Each appeal will be reviewed by Employee Health & Wellness as soon as administratively feasible after the appeal deadline (August 9th, 2024). The information will be compiled for the State Employee Health Commission who will meet to review appeals and render a decision. You will then be notified in writing of their decision.
