1. What was the deadline to complete the requirements for the Health Credit Premium Program?

By midnight on September 30, 2020

2. What types of situations will <u>not</u> be considered for an appeal?

Too busy, forgot, didn't read mail or e-mail, couldn't get into an on-site health screening, don't have access to a computer, etc.

3. What is the premium cost for the health insurance?

4. I have filed an appeal; when will I hear a decision on my appeal?

Each appeal will be reviewed by Employee Health & Benefits as soon as administratively feasible after the appeal deadline (December 4, 2020). The information will be compiled for the State Employee Health Commission who will meet to review appeals and render a decision. You will then be notified in writing of their decision.
