IV. Financial Reports	The FFLEO Trust returned 5.82% in 1Q 2024 (vs. 6.10% benchmark), with equities up 7.95% (vs. 8.32%) and bonds returning -0.82% (vs0.78%). The balance of the Trust was \$19.4 MM as of March 31 <sup>st</sup> . Overall, the quarter witnessed strong market performance, buoyed by positive economic data and corporate earnings, though concerns over geopolitical strife, inflation and interest rates persisted, influencing investor sentiment. The difference between the Trust's equity returns and the benchmark can be accounted for by the fossil-fuel
