Total and partial hip and knee replacements

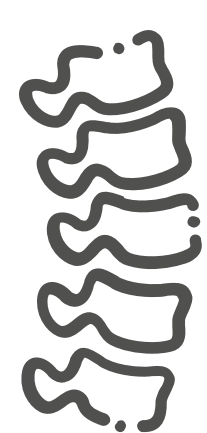


Note: Health plan members in need of total or partial hip or knee replacement surgery are required to go through Carrum Health for surgery expenses to be covered.



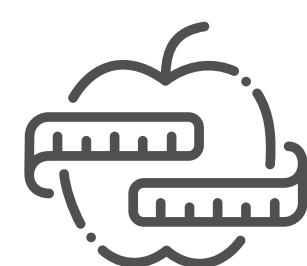
Musculoskeletal

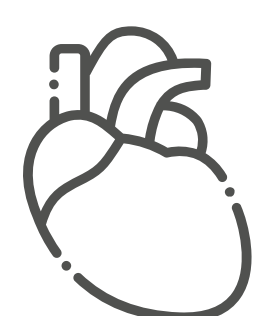
Spine

Surgical repair of your spine including spinal fusions and spinal decompressions.



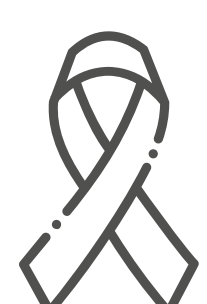
Weight Loss

Procedures to treat obesity including gastric bypass and gastric sleeve surgeries.



Heart

Procedures to correct various types of heart conditions.

What you need to know

Who is eligible?

- Those eligible for the Carrum Health benefit include active employees, early retirees, COBRA participants, and their adult dependents on the State of Maine Health Plan.

What procedures are covered?

- Covered procedures include total joint replacements and surgical repair of your bones, joints, muscles, and ligaments. Surgeries include hip, knee, shoulder, wrist, hand, ankle, and foot surgeries. Surgical repair of your spine including spinal fusions and spinal decompressions, procedures to correct various types of heart conditions, bariatric procedures and cancer treatments are also covered.

How much will I pay?

- When you receive care through Carrum, all surgery costs, including any necessary travel, are covered. No copays. No premiums. No surprise bills.
- Consultations and second opinions are provided at no cost to members, and do not require payment of any deductible.

Predictable and immediate cost savings

Carrum ensures more appropriate care and helps to avoid unnecessary and costly procedures and treatments through its unique partnering with these top providers. We bundle all of the services a patient may need (e.g. facility, provider and treatment fees) into one upfront payment with co-insurance and copayments paid for and covered by the State of Maine. Bills are sent directly to Carrum, avoiding potential out-of-pocket costs for you.

Bundled care details

Your benefit includes medical record collection, the 1st virtual/in-person consultation, the surgery, full hospital stay from admission to discharge for in-patient services, your first post-operative appointment with your Carrum provider, and any necessary lodging and travel for the patient and an adult companion. Post-surgical care takes place outside of Carrum and through your primary insurance (i.e. PT, PCP visits, urgent care/ER visits, etc). Should a complication or readmission arise within 30 days of your surgery, you’re fully covered through Carrum’s warranty and pay nothing when issues are reported to Carrum within 30 days and any necessary follow-up takes place where your surgical care was originally received.

Total support

From the moment you complete your profile with Carrum, you’re paired with a dedicated Carrum care specialist, who is there to help with all of the planning and paperwork, so you can focus on you and your health.

Exceptions for receiving hip or knee surgical care outside of Carrum Health

While it is mandatory for health plan members to go through Carrum Health for total or partial hip or knee replacement surgeries, exceptions can be made in the following cases*:

- If Spectrum Orthopaedics suggests inpatient surgery
 - It is medically unsafe to travel
 - Inability to secure an adult travel companion
- Severe financial hardship from rescheduling surgery including care giver obligations

To request coverage for surgery at a non-Carrum Health provider, please contact Carrum for an Exception Initiation Form to start the process.
