TO: All Agency Heads, Agency Human Resource/EEO Representatives

SUBJECT: New Process for Management-Initiated Reclassifications

On January 18, 2017, Governor Paul LePage announced to the members of his Cabinet that all management-initiated reclassifications and reorganizations must be approved by the Governor before being filed with the Bureau of Human Resources.

In accordance with that directive, a new simplified FJA form (FJA-MI) has been developed. In addition, a one-page Management Proposed Reclassification/Reorganization Justification Form has been developed for submission to the Governor's Office to request approval for the reclassification/reorganization. The forms are attached to this memorandum. "Pdf" versions as well as fillable forms (in Microsoft Word format) are also available on the Bureau of Human Resources website (www.maine.gov/bhr/employee_center/forms.htm).

Beginning immediately and until further notice, all management initiated reclassifications submitted to the Bureau of Human Resources must be on the new FJA-MI form and must be accompanied by a Management Proposed Reclassification/Reorganization Justification Form bearing the approval from the Governor's Office.
