The 2001 Holiday Schedule is issued under the provisions of Chapter 11 of the State of Maine Civil Service Rules and the Benefit Package for Confidential Employees.

Independence Day	Wednesday, July 4, 2001
Labor Day	Monday, September 3, 2001
Columbus Day	Monday, October 8, 2001
Veterans' Day	Monday, November 12, 2001 ²
Thanksgiving Day	Thursday, November 22, 2001
Thanksgiving Friday	Friday, November 23, 2001
Christmas	Tuesday, December 25, 2001

An employee who is required to work on any of these days will be granted compensatory time off at the mutual convenience of the employer and employee. If the holiday falls on a normal day off, an alternative compensatory day will be granted. Cash payments shall be made only in the instance of departmental policy established in conformance with Chapter 11, Section 1 of State of Maine Civil Service Rules.

To be eligible for holiday pay, employees must be in pay status on the normal workday immediately preceding and the normal workday immediately following the day and date on which the holiday is observed.
