DECISION

Plaintiff personally served Defendant on September 25, 1981, with a copy of Complaint, Amended Complaint and Summons. Defendant has failed to file an answer to the said Complaints. As a result thereof, a hearing was held at the Augusta District Court on December 2, 1981 on Plaintiff's Request for Judgment in Default to be granted against the Defendant. Appearing for the Plaintiff was Assistant Attorney General Michael Richards.

After hearing, the Court finds that the service process is in order and that a Decision in Default will be granted. Accordingly, the facts are found to be as stated in the Complaint and it is further ORDERED that the Defendant Gregory J. Flemming is in violation of 32 M.R.S.A. §2105(1) B, (C), (D) and (F), and as a result thereof, Defendant's license to practice nursing in

the State of Maine is hereby revoked forthwith.

The Defendant is further advised that Rule 73 of the Maine Administrative Court provides for an appeal of the decision of this Court to the Superior Court and that said appeal should be filed within ten (10) days from the date of the decision.
