CONSENT AGREEMENT PURSUANT
TO 32 M.R.S.A. § 2105-A
(1-A)(B)

This Consent Agreement is entered into by and among Stephen D. Marston (hereinafter "Mr. Marston"), the Maine State Board of Nursing (hereinafter "the Board") and the State of Maine Department of Attorney General following a meeting with the Board on October 27, 1988. Mr. Marston requested this meeting to discuss with the Board his request for reinstatement of his license. Following this meeting, the Board made the following findings of fact:

A. FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Mr. Marston voluntarily surrendered his license for a four-month period and entered into a Consent Agreement with the Board on June 17, 1988.
- 2. Mr. Marston has met all of the conditions of that Consent Agreement.
 - 3. Mr. Marston has had over six months of sobriety.

- 4. Mr. Marston is developing a support system.
- 5. Mr. Marston is actively involved in and plans to continue with a self-help group.

B. COVENANTS

The Board agrees to reinstate Mr. Marston's R.N. license on a probationary status for a two-year period under the following conditions:

- 1. Mr. Marston shall maintain sobriety and remain substance-free.
- 2. Mr. Marston shall maintain a counseling relationship with a Licensed Substance Abuse Counselor, as recommended by the counselor, and shall arrange for that counselor to provide to the Board quarterly and/or termination reports regarding Mr. Marston's progress.
- 3. Mr. Marston shall continue with AA and/or other self-help group.
- 4. If Mr. Marston is employed as a nurse, he shall show this agreement to his employer and shall arrange for his nurse/employer to submit to the Board quarterly reports of his work.
- 5. Mr. Marston agrees to waive any claim of confidentiality or privilege he may have with respect to any reports provided to the Board pursuant to this agreement.
- 6. Mr. Marston must return this signed agreement to the Board within 30 days of receipt or it is null and void,

and the reinstated license shall be considered to be under suspension.

7. Any violation of the terms of this agreement shall result in automatic revocation of Mr. Marston's R.N. license.

Mr. Marston understands that this document is a Consent Agreement which affects his right to practice nursing. Mr. Marston understands that he has the right to consult with an attorney before entering this Consent Agreement, and affirms that he executes this Consent Agreement of his own free will.

At the end of the two-year probationary term Mr. Marston may apply to the Board to have the probationary status lifted.
