**INTRODUCTION**

This document is a Consent Agreement regarding Melony M. Shorey's license to practice practical nursing in the State of Maine. The parties enter into this Agreement pursuant to 10 M.R.S.A. § 8003(5)(B) and 32 M.R.S.A. § 2105-A(1-A)(C). The parties to this Consent Agreement are Melony M. Shorey ("Licensee"), Maine State Board of Nursing ("Board") and the Department of Attorney General, State of Maine. The parties reached this Agreement following Ms. Shorey's request to voluntarily surrender her license by letter dated August 9, 2000, attached and incorporated within this Consent Agreement as Exhibit A.

**FACTS**

1. Melony M. Shorey was licensed as a licensed practical nurse in Maine in 1991.
2. Melony M. Shorey admits that she has a substance abuse problem and states in her letter to the Board: "At this point in my life I am coming to terms with being a drug addict." See Exhibit A.

**AGREEMENT**

3. The Maine State Board of Nursing will accept Melony M. Shorey's voluntary surrender of her practical nurse license.
4. Melony M. Shorey shall not work, in any capacity, in the health care field, including in a veterinarian's office, while her nursing license is surrendered. In addition, Ms. Shorey is not to seek employment where the handling or dispensing of drugs is part of the job responsibility.
5. Melony M. Shorey may petition the Board for reinstatement of her license. Ms. Shorey agrees and understands that her license will not be reinstated until and unless the Board, upon Ms. Shorey's written request, votes to reinstate Ms. Shorey's license.
6. Melony M. Shorey understands that this document imposes discipline regarding her license to practice nursing in the State of Maine for violations under 32 M.R.S.A. § 2105-A(2)(E) and A(2)(F).
7. Melony M. Shorey understands that she does not have to execute this Consent Agreement and that she has the right to consult with an attorney before entering into this Consent Agreement.
8. Melony M. Shorey affirms that she executes this Consent Agreement of her own free will.
9. Modification of this Consent Agreement must be in writing and signed by all parties.



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- 10. This Consent Agreement is not subject to review or appeal by the Licensee, but may be enforced by an action in the Superior Court.
- 11. This Consent Agreement becomes effective upon the date of the last necessary signature below.

I, MELONY M. SHOREY HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THE FOREGOING CONSENT AGREEMENT. I UNDERSTAND THAT BY SIGNING IT, I WAIVE CERTAIN RIGHTS. I SIGN IT VOLUNTARILY, WITHOUT ANY THREAT OR PROMISE. I UNDERSTAND THAT THIS CONSENT AGREEMENT CONTAINS THE ENTIRE AGREEMENT AND THERE IS NO OTHER AGREEMENT OF ANY KIND.
