

NCLEX “FIRST TIME” TEST TAKERS PASS RATES

Practical Nurses For the year October 1, 2010 through September 30, 2011, 96 first time candidates educated in Maine wrote the NCLEX examination for practical nurses and 84 passed, an 87.5 % pass rate.

Central Maine Community College: 8 out of 8 passed for a 100 % pass rate.

Intercoast Career Institute: 76 out of 88 passed for an 86.4 % pass rate.

Registered Nurses For the year October 1, 2010 through September 30, 2011, 695 first time candidates educated in Maine wrote the NCLEX examination for registered nurses and 626 passed, a 90% pass rate.

When reviewing statistics, keep in mind **absolute** numbers as well as percentages. (Percentages for smaller absolute numbers can vary widely.)

Nationally, RN first time candidates educated in member board jurisdictions: total was 144,570. Of that total, 125950 passed for a national pass rate of 87.8 % during Oct 1, 2010 through Sept. 30, 2011.

For PNs: 57,456 passed out of 66780 first time takers – 86%
