

NCLEX "FIRST TIME" TEST TAKERS PASS RATES

Practical Nurses For the year October 1, 2012 through September 30, 2013, 100 first time candidates educated in Maine wrote the NCLEX examination for practical nurses and 77 passed, a 77 % pass rate. (6 of 6 at CMCC passed for a 100 % pass rate and 71 of 94 at InterCoast Career Institute passed for a 75.5% pass rate). During the same time period a total of 59,147 U.S. educated first time test takers wrote the NCLEX-PN and 50,084 passed for a national pass rate of 84.7%.

Registered Nurses For the year October 1, 2012 through September 30, 2013, 738 first time candidates educated in Maine wrote the NCLEX examination for registered nurses and 609 passed, an 82.52 % pass rate. During the same time period a total of 154,963 U.S. educated first time test takers wrote the NCLEX-RN and 130,618 passed for a national pass rate of 84.3%.
