This financial order establishes allotment in the Personal Services and All Other line categories. Funding is required in this account for economic development and small business assistance. Maine is working on a micro-enterprise program to make one-time working capital grants based on lost revenue. Plans are to also partner with the largest food bank in the state to purchase food and work with the vast statewide network of the other food banks to increase the supply and access to food. The agency will develop an emergency 3 month living expense program delivered through the statewide Community Action Agencies. Funds are provided through the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act).
