Planning Grants are grants to help produce plans that define local broadband needs and goals. Phase I includes community organizing, needs and objectives, provider engagement, digital inclusion and possible funding. Phase II includes engineering and network design.

- No match is required but additional points are given if you do have a match
- The scoring criteria has changed slightly, so it is important for you to review. The scoring criteria includes engagement & participation, project focus, project preparation & financial commitment.
- ▶ There is no appeal process.
- ▶ One year to complete the project unless an extension is approved by the Board.
- ▶ Routine reporting & check-ins are required to receive grant payments.
