CCPSC Meeting Minutes

Thursday August 27, 2026

- 1. Call to Order:** Meeting was called to order at 11:08am.
- 2. Welcome & Introduction of Guests:** Council members Tim Curtis, Sheriff Lancaster, Sheriff Samson, Nathan Thayer and Steve French were present. Council members Skip Herrick and Erica LaCroix were absent. A quorum was met. Council Clerk Mary-Anne LaMarre was also on the call.
- 3. Approval of the minutes of the meeting of August 13, 2026:** Motion by Sheriff Samson to approve the minutes, seconded by Sheriff Lancaster. Motion carries.
- 4. Old Business:**
 - A. Discuss Standard P32 considering LD1971 interpretation:** Steve French reported that discussions with the MDOC are ongoing about whether to repeal or edit Standard P32 as it conflicts with some interpretations of the new law regarding relationships with jails and ICE detainees. Any decision to change the standard will go through the regular public notice process. Steve said there are other standard changes that the Council will review and P32 will be part of those conversations later this year.
- 5. New Business**
 - A. Review Jail Operations Distribution for FY27:** Mitch Boynton was not on the call but had reviewed the distribution model with Tim via email. There are some slight changes based on bed days. There was a question from Waldo County as to whether the numbers were based on FY26 or FY25. It was determined that the count was based on FY26 and Mitch needed to update the heading on his spread sheet.
- 6. Other Business:** The group discussed the possibility of putting in an Emergency Supplemental Budget request. Nathan Thayer mentioned that the Department typically submits a request to cover unanticipated shortfalls in the FY27 Budget. This submission is separate from the FY28 Biennial Budget request that the Council has already submitted. Tim will reach out to Mitch Boynton to confirm the process for submitting an emergency supplemental request.
