A power of attorney or grant of guardianship document other than a court order is not acceptable. The parent or legal guardian giving permission is not required to be an approved visitor. A person giving permission cannot be a prisoner unless the prisoner provides proof that the rights of the other parent have been terminated (court order) or that the prisoner has been granted sole parental rights (court order). All documentation must be received by the Chief Administrative Officer, or designee, at least two (2) business days prior to requesting the visit."
