1. Title of crime or civil violation. Include statute citation.
2. Defendant's name, date of birth, height, weight, eye color, hair color, driver's license number, issuing state for the driver's license, address, and telephone number.
3. For all animals cruelly treated: breed, description, and name.
4. Photos of the animals cruelly treated.
5. Photos of the area where the animals were kept showing things such as empty food and water bowls, feces covering the floor, urine-soaked papers/carpets, pills, needles, and other trash which could be ingested by the animals, and any other photos demonstrating animal cruelty.
6. Dates and times of: your arrival at scene; the incident; conversations with witness(es), victim and defendant.
7. Conversations you had with the defendant, State vet, the vet who treated the animals, if the animals were seized and brought to a shelter, any conversation you had with anyone at the shelter, anyone with information relevant to the case. Put these in narrative form.
8. Written statements by anyone referenced in number 7 above.
9. Copies examinations of the animals by a vet, shelter employee, and anyone else who examined the animals.
10. Name and title of investigation officer and assisting officer(s) or other officers at scene.
11. Copies of vet and boarding bills for the animals.
