



Maine Senior FarmShare Program Eligibility Guidelines

- Must be a Maine resident
- Must be age 60 or over (Age 55 or over for Native Americans)
- Must have a gross annual household income (including all pensions, social security and other payments) of no more than 185% of the poverty level (see below).

2020-2021 Income Eligibility Guidelines

SFMNP income eligibility guidelines are effective from July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021.

The outlined number below refers to the household size (# of people residing in household). The household gross annual income must be below the dollar amount after each outlined number of household size to be income eligible. **Income of all members in the household must be counted towards meeting income eligibility guidelines.**

1-	\$23,606	2-	\$31,894	3-	\$40,812	4-	\$48,470	5-	\$56,758	6-	\$65,046
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Income eligibility guidelines are subject to change. If they change, new income eligibility guidelines will be effective July 1, 2021.

Farmers will be notified if/when they do change on or before July 1, 2021.
