TO: Maine Property Owners:

The Maine Floodplain Management Program works with individuals, communities and professionals to reduce the risk of flooding. A Risk Mapping Assessment and Planning (Risk MAP) project is moving forward in your region, the southern portion of the Lower Penobscot HUC 8 Watershed, for the purpose of improving the accuracy of flood risk information. As part of this effort, AECOM Technical Services, Inc. and Nadeau Land Surveys will be conducting field surveys and remote sensed measurements of structures in and near regulated floodplains. The State has been in contact with your county and municipal officials to inform them of this project and to obtain their input regarding the need for improved flood risk information in your community.

Project field surveyors will make every effort to stay on public lands and right of ways; however, it may be necessary for the surveyors to enter your property for short periods of time. Should this occur, an employee from the surveying team will make a bona fide, good faith attempt to contact you in advance to seek permission. The surveyors will respect your property and will not interfere with your use of it. Upon request, the surveyors will identify themselves by driver's license or state identification and this letter of introduction from the Maine Floodplain Management Program.
