## MAINE STATE HARNESS RACING COMMISSION DECISION AND ORDER IN RE: HEATH CAMPBELL

Based on the evidence reviewed by the Commission at the appeal hearing held on January 25, 2021 the Commission adopts the following Findings of Fact as follows:

- 1. Appellant Campbell raced the horse named- Derby Lady in the first race at Bangor Raceway on August 1, 2021.
- 2. The judges at the track reviewed the race and concluded that Derby Lady had interfered with other horses. As a result of their finding Derby Lady was placed for the violation.
- 3. Appellant filed a written appeal on August 4, 2021.
- 4. A review of the race video indicates that the violation as found by the judges did occur.

Based on these Findings of Fact, the Commission concludes that the Department has proven, by a preponderance of the evidence, that a violation did occur.

Therefore, as a matter of law, the APPEAL is DENIED.

It shall also contain a concise statement as to the nature of the action or inaction to be reviewed, the grounds upon which relief is sought and a demand for relief. Copies of the Petition for Review shall be served by Certified Mail, Return Receipt Requested upon the MAINE STATE HARNESS RACING COMMISSION, all parties to the agency proceedings and the Attorney General.
