MAINE STATE HARNESS RACING COMMISSION DECISION AND ORDER IN RE: BRUCE RANGER

Based on the evidence reviewed by the Commission at the appeal hearing held on January 25, 2021 the Commission adopts the following Findings of Fact as follows:

- 1. Appellant Ranger raced the horse named- Bali in the second race at Bangor Raceway October 28, 2021.
- 2. The judges at the track reviewed the race and concluded that Bali had interfered with other horses. As a result of their finding Bali was placed for the violation.
- 3. Appellant filed a written appeal on November 1, 2021.
- 4. A review of the race video indicates that the violation as found by the judges did occur.

Based on these Findings of Fact, the Commission concludes that the Department has proven, by a preponderance of the evidence, that a violation did occur.

Therefore, as a matter of law, the APPEAL is DENIED.

Copies of the Petition for Review shall be served by Certified Mail, Return Receipt Requested upon the MAINE STATE HARNESS RACING COMMISSION, all parties to the agency proceedings and the Attorney General.
