GENERAL NOTIFICATION

WHO NEEDS TO SUBMIT THIS NOTIFICATION?

Anyone conducting timber harvesting, Level B road projects or water crossings of minor flowing waters (P-SL2s) in subdistricts where these uses are <u>allowed without a permit subject to standards</u> in the plantations, unorganized townships and certain towns in the Maine Land Use Planning Commission ("LUPC" or "Commission") service area, and which conform with standards of Section 10.27,D of the *Commission's Land Use District and Standards*.

This notification is not for use for timber harvesting or road and water crossings associated with land management roads regulated by the Maine Forest Service. Contact the Maine Forest Service at (207) 287-2791 for more information.

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES MAY NOT BEGIN PRIOR TO SUBMISSION OF A COMPLETED, SIGNED NOTIFICATION

THE LANDOWNER MAY PROCEED WITH THE PROPOSED PROJECT AFTER FORMALLY FILING A COMPLETED NOTIFICATION WITH THE COMMISSION UNLESS THE COMMISSION STAFF INFORMS THE LANDOWNER IN WRITING THAT ISSUES HAVE BEEN IDENTIFIED BY THE COMMISSION STAFF REGARDING THE ADEQUACY IN WHICH THE COMMISSION'S RULES ARE MET.
