Adopted Rule Revision: Exceptions to Dimensional Requirements for Public Recreational Facilities

The following amendments make changes to Chapter 10, Land Use Districts and Standards for Areas within the Jurisdiction of the Maine Land Use Planning Commission. This document only includes relevant sections of Chapter 10 and indicates additions in <u>underline</u> and deletions with a strikethrough.

10.26 DIMENSIONAL REQUIREMENTS

G. EXCEPTIONS TO DIMENSIONAL REQUIREMENTS

- **18.** For lots improved with public recreational facilities the minimum lot size is 20,000 square feet, the minimum shoreline frontage is 100 feet, and the minimum road frontage is 100 feet, provided:
 - the abutting land is subject, in perpetuity, to legally binding provisions that prohibit incompatible land uses in locations that would be adversely affected by the public recreational facility, and
 - 2) the public recreational facility is otherwise sufficiently sized to fulfill the use for which it is designed.

For lots improved with a public trailered ramp or public hand-carry launch that do not satisfy the above provisions, but where the ramp or launch will not have an undue adverse impact on existing uses in the project area, the minimum shoreline frontage is 200 feet. Except as provided here, the dimensional requirements contained in Section 10.26, A through F apply to lots improved with public recreational facilities. For purposes of this section, public recreational facilities are trailered ramps and hand-carry launches; trailheads; and associated facilities; that are owned, leased, or operated by a public entity and made available with or without a fee.

10.27 ACTIVITY-SPECIFIC STANDARDS

L. TRAILERED RAMPS, HAND-CARRY LAUNCHES, AND WATER-ACCESS WAYS

5. Design and Construction Standards for Trailered Ramps and Hand-carry Launches.

Unless otherwise <u>indicatedstated</u>, the following standards apply to trailered ramps and hand-carry launches that are subject to the notification provisions in Section 10.27,L,4, and to all commercial or private trailered ramps and hand-carry launches.

n. Dimensional Requirements. <u>The dimensional requirements in Section 10.26 apply. The</u> shoreline frontage requirement for public boat launches may be waived to no less than 200 feet provided the applicant demonstrates there will be no undue adverse impact to existing uses in the project area.
