The Maine Land Use Planning Commission is proposing to repeal Chapter 3 and to repeal and replace Chapters 4 and 5. The changes proposed for each of these three rules collectively will improve user convenience by consolidating or reorganizing provisions without changing their regulatory effect, and revise visual characteristics to simplify or otherwise clarify each rule. Some edits propose to simplify the rule by consolidating notice provisions, clarify existing practice, and include provisions previously located in Chapter 10 of the Commission's rules. All other revisions represent typical rule maintenance.
