1.	For the professional logger, safety on the worksite is the number one priority. The professional logger abides by and <u>promotes safety</u> standards.
2.	Professional loggers take <u>pride</u> in their profession, perform all activities in a responsible and professional manner, and encourage others to do the same.
3.	The professional logger <u>protects</u> our natural environment and enhances our natural resources by operating in accordance with sound forest management and environmental principles.
4.	The professional logger is <u>aware</u> of all laws and regulations relating to the profession of logging and performs all duties to the highest standards.
5.	The professional logger does not perform any service for which he or she is not qualified, and will <u>advise</u> clients to seek other professional assistance when appropriate.
6.	The professional logger recognizes landowners, wood buyers, and other professionals are part of the industry and works with them to maintain standards of professionalism.
7.	The professional logger will <u>keep up with changes</u> in the logging profession and in laws and guidelines relating to the profession.
8.	The professional logger implements a contracted harvest with the explicit intent of <u>achieving</u> goals of the forest landowner, or their agent.
