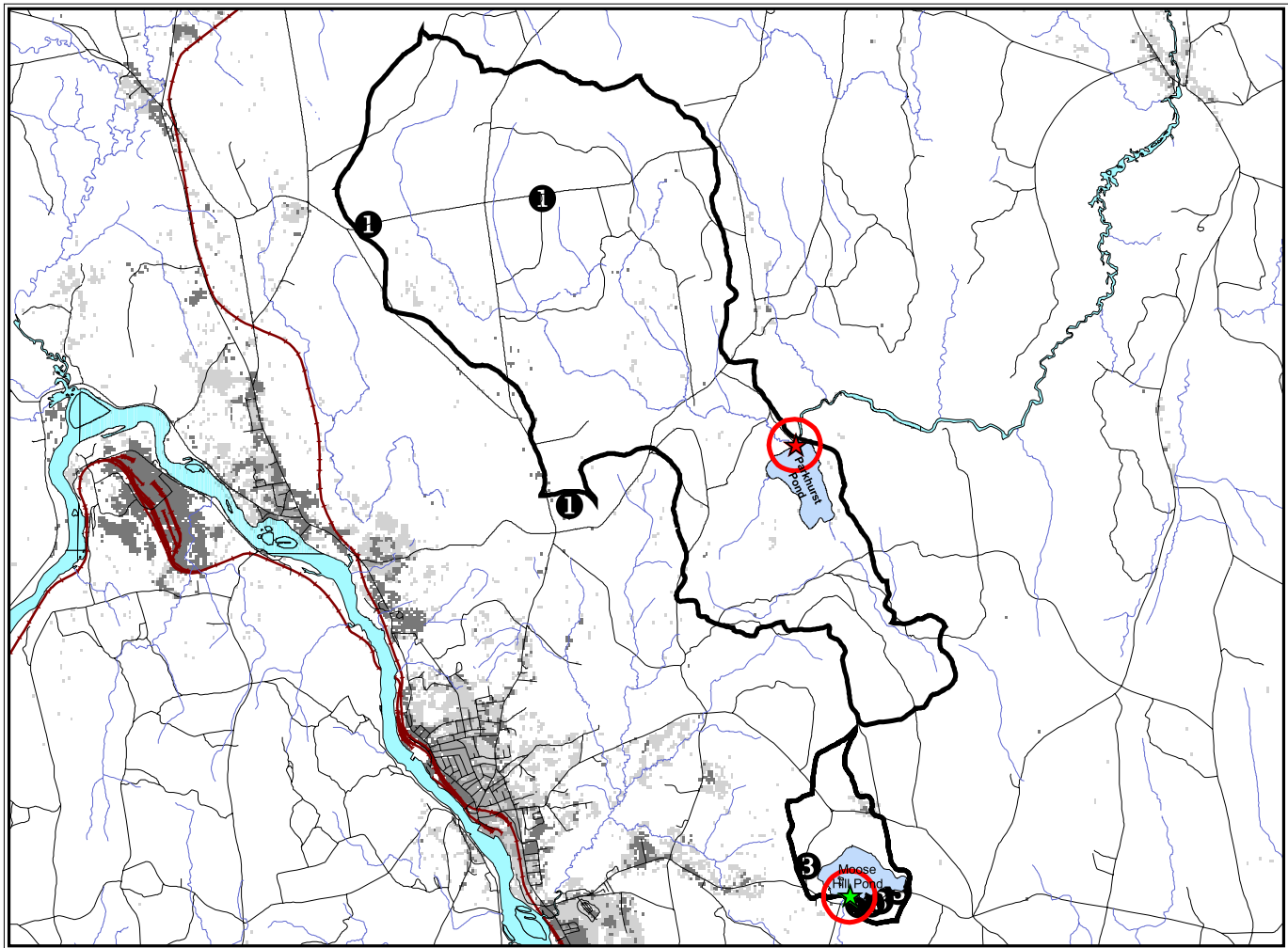




Livermore Falls Public Water Supply Residential/Commercial/Industrial/Transportation & Potential Threats to Drinking Water

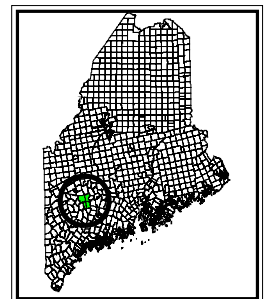
