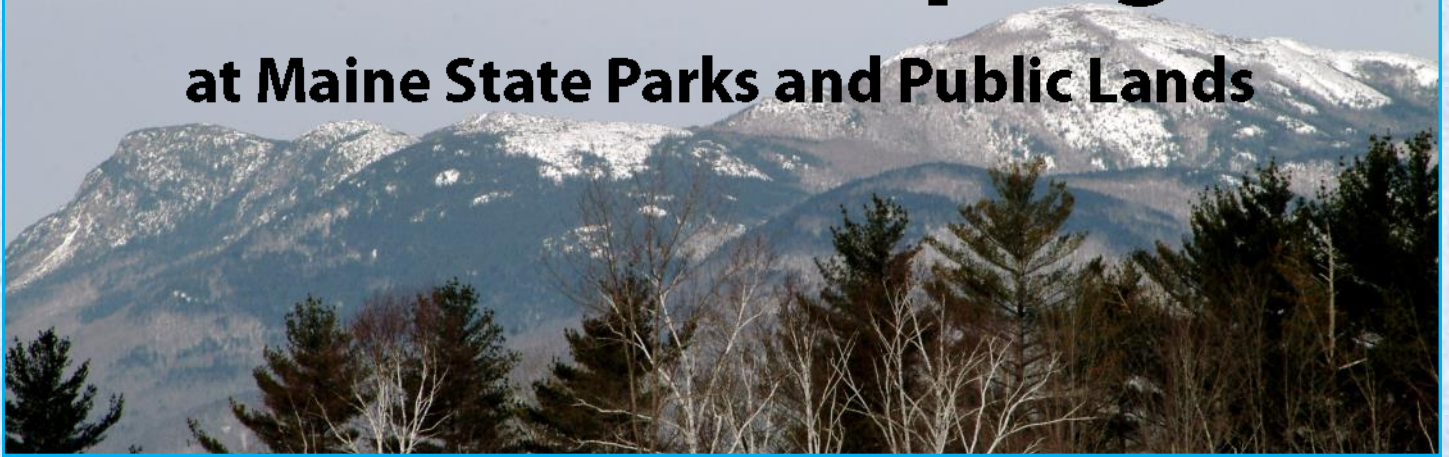


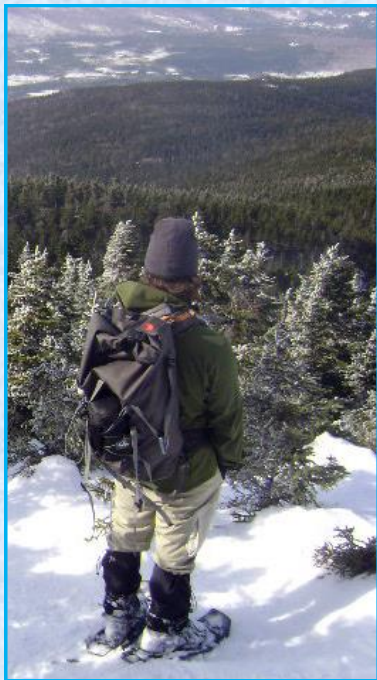
Winter Camping
