ADDITIONAL COMMENTS: Joe-Overall your plants look great, the hanging baskets look particularly good this year. There are a few more shoreflies then I would like to see in Greenhouse 2. Shoreflies like areas that are wet and I noticed some of the plants in Greenhouse 2 are being overwatered. I think if you can dry things out you should see the shorefly population decline. Keep an eye on the thrips population. They are not doing any damage at this time, but can transmit viruses that make the plants unsaleable. Continuing to remove dead flowers and foliage and reducing humidity will help keep your botrytis levels down.
