FOLLOW PLANT HEALTH REGULATIONS WHEN SHIPPING WREATHS & TREES

	Plant Material	Shipping to	Conditions
General	All plant material	All locations	Clearly mark the outside of all packages with: - The contents (ex. 1 balsam fir wreath) "Grown in Maine" and the county of origin. - The name and address of the shipper. Plant material must be healthy & free of pests
	All trees with roots (such as small potted or B&B trees)	All locations	State certification & nursery license is required.
		AK,AL,AR,AZ,CA,CO,HI,ID,MS,MT,ND,NM,NV,OK,OR,SD,TX,UT,WA	Prohibited unless certified free of Japanese beetle
	All wreaths and trees (cut or rooted)	All foreign countries except Canada	Prohibited*
		AK,AL,AR,AZ,CA,CO,FL,GA,HI,IA,ID,KY,KS,LA,MO,MS,MT,ND,NE,NM,NV,OK,OR,SC,SD,TN,TX,UT,WA,WY and parts of IL,IN,MN,NC,OH,VA,WI,WV	Inspected & certified free of spongy moth (formerly known as gypsy moth).
	All trees (cut or rooted)	Canada	Certification required
	All trees (cut)	Florida	Compliance agreement & Certification required
	Wreaths	Canada	Unrestricted except wreaths containing pine require certification .
Greenery	All evergreen species	WI	Inspected & certified free of elongate hemlock scale.
	Fir (<i>Abies spp</i> including balsam fir)	MI	Trees, wreaths & boughs allowed October 15 to January 1
	Hemlock (<i>Tsuga spp</i>)	OH,VT,WI and parts of ME	Prohibited*
		MI	Trees, wreaths & boughs allowed October 15 to January 1
	Juniper (<i>Juniperus spp.</i>)	CA	Prohibited*
		Canada	Certification required
		CA	Wreaths allowed
	Pine (<i>Pinus spp</i>)		Trees & loose branches Prohibited*
		HI	Allowed October 20 to December 31
		MT	Inspection & certification required
		NC	Trees inspection & certification required
Decorations	Chestnuts (<i>Castanea spp.</i>)	OR,WA	Prohibited*
	Citrus	AL,AZ,CA,FL,GA,TX	Prohibited*
	Asiatic bittersweet (<i>Celastrus orbiculatus</i>)	All locations	Prohibited
	Fruits of: apple, crabapple, hawthorn, <i>Prunus</i> spp, quince, pear	AZ,CA,ID,OR,WA	Prohibited*
	Hazlenuts (<i>Corylus spp.</i>)	OR,WA	Must be free of twigs or other plant debris
	Multiflora rose (<i>Rosa multiflora</i>)	All locations	Prohibited
	Persimmon (<i>Diospyros spp.</i>)	CA,WA	Prohibited*
	Nuts of walnut & butternut (<i>Juglans spp.</i>)	AZ,CA,TX	Prohibited*
	Nuts of pecan & hickory (<i>Carya spp.</i>)	AZ,CA,NM,TX	Prohibited*

* Some prohibited plant material may be allowed under certain conditions.
