MEMORANDUM

TO: All Industry Members

RE: Reminder of Permissible Activities in On Premises Establishments

DATE: April 2, 2020

This memo is intended to be a reminder and serve as further guidance on the permissible activities and mandates under Governor Mills' existing Executive Orders.

- A. All on-premises establishments **may**:
 - 1. Remain open for curbside pick-up or delivery only; and
 - 2. Sell beer and wine in the manufacturers' original sealed container with food orders only.
- B. All on-premises establishments **must** adhere to the strict social and physical distancing requirements as mandated by the Governor on March 31st (see my Memo of April 1st).
- C. All on-premises establishment **must not**:
 - 1. Sell any beer, wine or spirits for consumption on the premises;
 - 2. Fill and/or sell growlers or crowlers from taps in their establishments (this does not apply to Maine licensed breweries with an associated restaurant license); and
 - 3. Create and/or sell cocktails to go in any type of container, sealed or otherwise.
