RE:	Updated Guidance for openings of on-premises licensees for June 1 st
DATE:	May 27, 2020

This memo is intended to update the Bureau's <u>guidance memo of May 14th</u> regarding the opening of restaurants for May 18th and June 1st that are liquor licensees.

Today, Governor Mills amended her Re-Opening Plan for Maine's Economy to allow restaurants in Penobscot county to open for on-premises consumption of food and all types of beverages on June 1st; this includes **both** inside and outside dining. Additionally, the Governor announced that restaurants in Androscoggin, Cumberland and York counties can be open for outside dining **only** on June 1st.
