
Basics of Maine State Contracts & Grants



MAINE PROCUREMENT GUIDING PRINCIPLES

- Open and competitive bidding process for awarding Maine state contracts and grants to eligible suppliers/ applicants.
- Awards based on best value for the people of Maine considering cost, quality, timeliness of delivery, and other factors.



- Carefully review the solicitation document:
 - ⇒ Request for Proposals (RFP) For awarding contracts
 - ⇒ Request for Application (RFA) For awarding grants
- Follow all instructions provided in the RFP or RFA for preparing and submitting your proposal or grant application
