1. Provide a more detailed description and explain the need for the goods, services or grant to supplement the response in Part I.	The Sabattus Pond Dam Commission (SPDC) will contract with H.E. Callahan Construction Co., or another qualified construction contractor, to carry out updates to Sabattus Pond Dam including, but not limited to: replacing the water control mechanisms, replacing the top cap and other concrete features on the dam, adding downstream buttresses, completing structural tie-ins to both banks, and constructing the denil fishway. In addition, this work includes contracting with Acadia Civil Works, or another qualified engineering firm, to oversee construction activities and monitor for compliance with state and federal permit requirements.
2. Provide a brief justification for the selected vendor to supplement the response in Part II. Reference the RFP number, if applicable.	The SPDC is a quasi-municipal organization formed by the Towns of Sabattus, Greene, and Wales to maintain and manage the Sabattus Dam. The SPDC has cooperated with MDMR to complete joint engineering drawings for the dam repair and fishway work to be completed at the site. As the owner of the dam, the SPDC feels it is the appropriate entity to hold a construction contract for work on the dam. MDMR is providing pass-through funding to the SPDC in this contract to supplement funding SPDC already holds to complete the work at the dam. There is no other entity that would take on this role.
3. Explain how the negotiated costs or rates are fair and reasonable; or how the funding was allocated to grantee.	The SPDC has followed the appropriate procurement procedures (i.e. public competitive bid) to award a contract to HE Callahan Construction and Acadia Civil works to carry out the tasks identified in this service contract. MDMR has participated in the review of these procurement procedures.
4. Describe the plan for future competition for the goods or services.	If in the future, if another vendor becomes available that has the adequate facilities and capabilities to fill this role, we will evaluate each equally.
