1. Provide a more detailed description and explain the need for the goods, services or grant to supplement the response in Part I.

The Mini-CALIBER® RF Range Extender (Video/Data) Increases the wireless operating Video/Data range of your Mini-Caliber robot with the Mini-CALIBER RF Range Extender. It is mounted on a portable tripod (additional suction cup and magnetic mounts included), an additional transmitter and receiver can be directly connected to the CCU using a 20' (6m) of hardwire tether. Key uses include extending RF range; ability to have antennae mounted outside armored vehicles.

Includes one CAL-EB3 MINI CCU battery pack.
 **These extenders are needed ASAP so that we can deploy the robots inside a residence during a tactical or bomb operation. Recently, we have learned when we do deploy them inside, we lose the signal between the remote and robot which has left us inoperable. These robots are used to protect the life safety of our tactical and bomb team personnel and it is essential to have the extenders to ensure proper operability.

ICOR technology is a cutting-edge robotics company. We purchased three robots from them just a few years ago. ICOR technology is the only vendor for these extenders as it is their product and not available on the open market.

The cost of the extenders (2), 500' tether, and shipping was quoted by ICOR. The prices for this needed equipment have not increased since our last quote which was 2020.


